






Likely Exposed Areas for Flash Flooding 01 May-08 May 2024 10

Potential Impact:

- Light to moderate rains are expected that trigger flash flooding in local nullahs/streams of Balochistan especially (Gwadar, Kech, Washuk, Chagai. Chaman, Killa Abdullah, Killa Saifullah & Zhob) & flash flooding in highlighted areas of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa & AJK.
- Moderate rainfall may generate flash flooding in hill torrents of DG Khan and Rajanpur.
- Localized flooding may disrupt roads during the forecasted period.
- Local residents & tourists are advised to avoid unnecessary traveling and are advised to remain cautious during the spell and check weather updates before traveling.
- Electricity/ other utility services may get disrupted.






Likely Exposed Areas for Flash Flooding 01 May-08 May 2024 11

Light to moderate rainfall is anticipated so River Kabul at Nowshera and its tributaries are likely to remain in rising trend with Low to High Flood **levels** during the forecast period. These rains are likely to cause a surge in water levels within streams and nullahs especially (Dir, Malakand, Charsadda, Swat, Mardan, Bajaur, Mohmand & Khyber Agency)

Light to moderate rainfall may generate flash flooding in local nullahs/Streams of Balochistan specially (Gwadar, Kech, Washuk, Chagai, Chaman, Killa Abdullah, Killa Saifullah & Zhob) and low lying surrounding areas.








River Flows 01 May-08 May 2024

- River Kabul at Nowshera is likely to remain in rising trend with Medium to High Flood levels during the forecast period. Current Flood Level at Nowshera 75,000 cusec which is expected to reach above 130,000 cusec from 02nd to 06th May 2024.
- River Swat is also expected to show rising trends in the forecast period with discharge reaching up to 50,000 cusecs at Munda headwork.
- River Mingora is expected to show rising trends with discharge reaching up to 35,000 cusecs.
- All the main rivers of Indus River System (Indus, Jhelum, Chenab, Ravi, Sutlej) are expected to flow with normal discharges.





As per NEOC's meteorological projections, dry weather is expected in most part of the country while light to moderate rainfall is expected in Balochistan and AJK from 5th – 7th May, 2024.

No adverse event is anticipated in first week of May, however people visiting the highlighted areas of very high and high risk zones are advised to be careful during the rainfall spell.
