#### SUBJECT: -RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:

#### I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION at 0600 PST:

River Indus at Guddu & Sukkur and River Sutlej at Ganda Singh Wala, Sulemanki & Islam are in Low flood level.

#### II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:

- a. Yesterday's trough of westerly wave over Northeast Afghanistan persists.
- b. Mild moist currents from Arabian Sea are penetrating to central parts of the country up to 5000 feet.
- c. Seasonal low lies over Northeast Balochistan.

#### III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:

Scattered wind thunderstorm/rain of moderate intensity is expected over the upper catchments of Rivers Indus & Kabul. 
