SUBJECT: -RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST: I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION at 0600 PST:

All the Major Rivers are flowing Below Low Flood level. Nullah Deg at Kingra Bridge may attain Low to Medium flood level during next 24-hours.

II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:

- a. Yesterday's trough of westerly over Northern parts of the country today lies over Kashmir & adjoining areas.
- Yesterday's well marked low over Southeast Rajasthan today lies over West Rajasthan and has weakened b. into low.
- Strong moist currents from Arabian Sea are penetrating to Sindh and Eastern Balochistan up to 10000 c. feet. Light moist currents from Arabian Sea are penetrating to South Punjab up to 5000 feet.
- d. Weak Seasonal low lies over West Balochistan.
- III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:

Scattered to widespread wind thunderstorm/rain of moderate to heavy intensity is expected over Sindh & Eastern Balochistan. Scattered wind thunderstorm/rain of moderate intensity with isolated heavy falls is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers, Islamabad along with Peshawar, Kohat, Bannu, D.I Khan, Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Sargodha, Lahore, Faisalabad & Sahiwal Divisions. Isolated wind thunderstorm/rain of light to moderate intensity is expected over Multan, D.G Khan & Bahawalpur Divisions.
